The property owner(s) and/or lienholder(s) were notified by regular mail that the Board would act on this nuisance situation at a Public Hearing on September 28, 2009 at 6:20 p.m. The property owner was present for said Public Hearing at which time a resolution was made by the Board to table their decision for two weeks, pending an inspection by the Zoning Administrator to insure progress is being made (09-352). A NOTICE TO ABATE THE NUISANCE(S) and a copy of this resolution will be sent to the property owner(s) and/or lienholder(s) by certified and regular mail or published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the township, if the owner's address is unknown and cannot reasonably be obtained.
