"Ohio case law provides that if there is an intent of the owner of land underneath a road to dedicate it for public use and the public subdivision has accepted the land for the public's use by maintenance and usage the a formal dedication is not required. *Railroad Company v. Roseville* (1907) 76 Ohio St. 108. There is also precedent that even without an intended dedication, common usage, by the general public for a period of 21 years dedicates the road by adverse prescription. *United States Construction Company v. Danbury Township*, (2002) 2002-Ohio-3428.

Based upon the facts as I understand them the Lake Township Board of Trustees has authority and jurisdiction to maintain the unnamed alley. However, the type and level of maintenance is within the sound discretion of the Board of Trustees and its Road Superintendent. Whether or not to pave, chip and seal, or gravel remains within your sole discretion. So long as the alley is reasonably passable and clear of any obstructions the Board and Road Department are immune from other claims."
